The purpose of this amendment is to provide answers to bidders' questions.

Question. Will travel CLIN cover all travel to and from Paris, as well as work trips abroad? How often will the candidate(s) need to travel to-from Paris and for how long should they plan to stay there on average?

Answer: ABMC's preferred arrangement is full-time on-site support in Paris, France. However, ABMC may allow a hybrid arrangement (remote within Europe with periodic on-site presence in Paris) to attract the most qualified candidates, subject to mission needs and COR/CO direction.

Under any hybrid arrangement, the Contract Specialist will be expected to provide regular on-site support in Paris. The frequency and duration of on-site support will be determined based on operational requirements and coordinated with the COR.

Offerors should not include travel costs in their proposed fully burdened hourly labor rates. Authorized travel, including travel to and from Paris for approved on-site support and travel to other ABMC locations, will be reimbursed under the travel CLIN, in accordance with the Federal Travel Regulation (FTR) and subject to prior approval.

ABMC cannot provide a fixed travel schedule at this time. Offerors should propose reasonable travel assumptions and clearly state those assumptions in their proposals.
